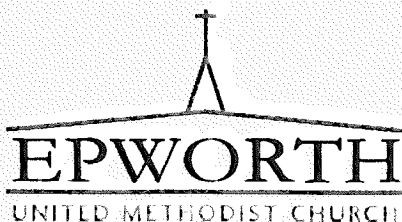
Rev. Carolyn Schuldt - Executive Director, Open Table Ministry

Open Table Ministry seeks out and guides those experiencing homelessness and poverty to long-term health and wholeness by building ongoing trusting relationships, meeting practical and personal needs, making connections to community resources, and bridging critical gaps in the social services system.

At Open Table Ministry, we are intentional about *befriending*, *building* strong relationships with and *serving* the homeless members of our community who are pushed aside, living unsheltered, often to be unnoticed, disregarded or ignored.

She holds a Bachelors Degree in Social Work from Meredith College (2006) and a Master of Divinity from Duke Divinity School (2009).
